Visual inspection of equipment which will be used to complete job. Job to be postponed if inspections fail to meet expectations. Any vehicle in work on site or pathways must be signed, lit and manned. Inspect access to site and manhole covers to make sure they are in good condition and suitable to lift. Daily vehicle and equipment checks. PPE inspections and report to office if any are in a poor condition and replace for new.
